NOTICE OF RACE

SOUTH CAERNARVONSHIRE YACHT CLUB
ABERSOCH NORTH WALES

Racing for:-

All classes of Dinghies from Optimists to 49ers.

Asymmetrics (PYS up to 1010); Mixed Dinghies (Fast & Slow PYS Up to 1180); Single Handers.

Any Fleet of less than 10 (Ten) boats may be moved to the relevant Handicap Fleet. Any Fleet of 10 (or more) may be given their own start.

The Races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the National Authority and the Sailing Instructions. The Event is designated Category C.

Registration will be in the Clubhouse from 10.00 to 13.00 and 14.00 to 17.00 hrs on Saturday 22nd July and 09.00 to 10.00 hrs on Sunday 23rd July. Briefing will be in the Clubhouse on **Sunday at 09.00 hrs** for morning classes and 12.00 hrs for afternoon classes.

Distribution of classes for morning and afternoon races will be published on Official Notice Board at midday on Saturday 22nd July 2017

The Start of the first race will be on **Sunday 23rd July at 10.00 hr**. All other race days start at 10.00hrs. Afternoon races start 14.00 hrs on all race days.

Entry Fees are for 6 days racing or less.

Entry Fee (non SCYC member) (inclusive of Council Slipway charges) will be:

£99.00 if received before 1st June

£125 between 2nd June and 18th July

Entries on the Days of Registration will be charged £165.00

SCYC Members

£60.00 if received before 1st June

£80.00 between the 2nd June and 18th July

Entries on the Days of Registration will be charged £105

Double discount – Helm sailing am/pm - £55 for second boat (**SCYC and Non Members**)

No late entries after 09.00 hrs Sunday 23rd July 2017

Optimist Sailing/Racing/Training off the beach. Times and full details to be announced later.

The Crewsaver Club Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the best performing team consisting of 3 nominated boats from different classes from the same Club. Only 1 team per Club allowed. Details on Official Notice Board. Entries must be received by 10.00 hrs Sunday 23rd July 2017.

Sailing Instructions will be available from Competition Reception.

Conditions of Entry: In signing the Entry Form helms will agree to the following:

1. I have insurance to cover third party for at least £2,000,000
2. I have a valid measurement certificate
3. I should carry an anchor & at least 60ft of warp during the week
4. I will wear a quick release harness if I am sailing a trapeze boat
5. Risk Statement

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.'

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore;
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, umpires and other officials and volunteers by the organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- g) [For off shore races] They are responsible for ensuring that their boat is equipped and seaworthy so as to be able to face extremes of weather; that there is a crew sufficient in number, experience and fitness to withstand such weather; and that the safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and is familiar to the crew.
